LIBRARY RULES

- Only current, paid BER members may check out library items.
- Members may check out a maximum of two video/audio tapes and one book at a time, for a maximum of one month, or the time between meetings. If you can't attend the next meeting, you are responsible for getting the item to the librarian before the meeting.
- When possible, we've made copies of our videos and put the copies into the library. However, many newer tapes are copy protected, so we've put the originals in the library. If a tape is damaged in your possession, you're responsible for the replacement cost, which may be \$40 to \$50.
- Out-of-town members are welcome to check out library materials. They will be charged \$5 plus return postage, to cover outbound postage and the mailing envelope.

Since the library has grown so large, it's cumbersome to transport the library to every meeting. If there's a specific tape or book you would like to check out, please contact the secretary before the next BER meeting.
